WORLD IMMUNIZATION WEEK

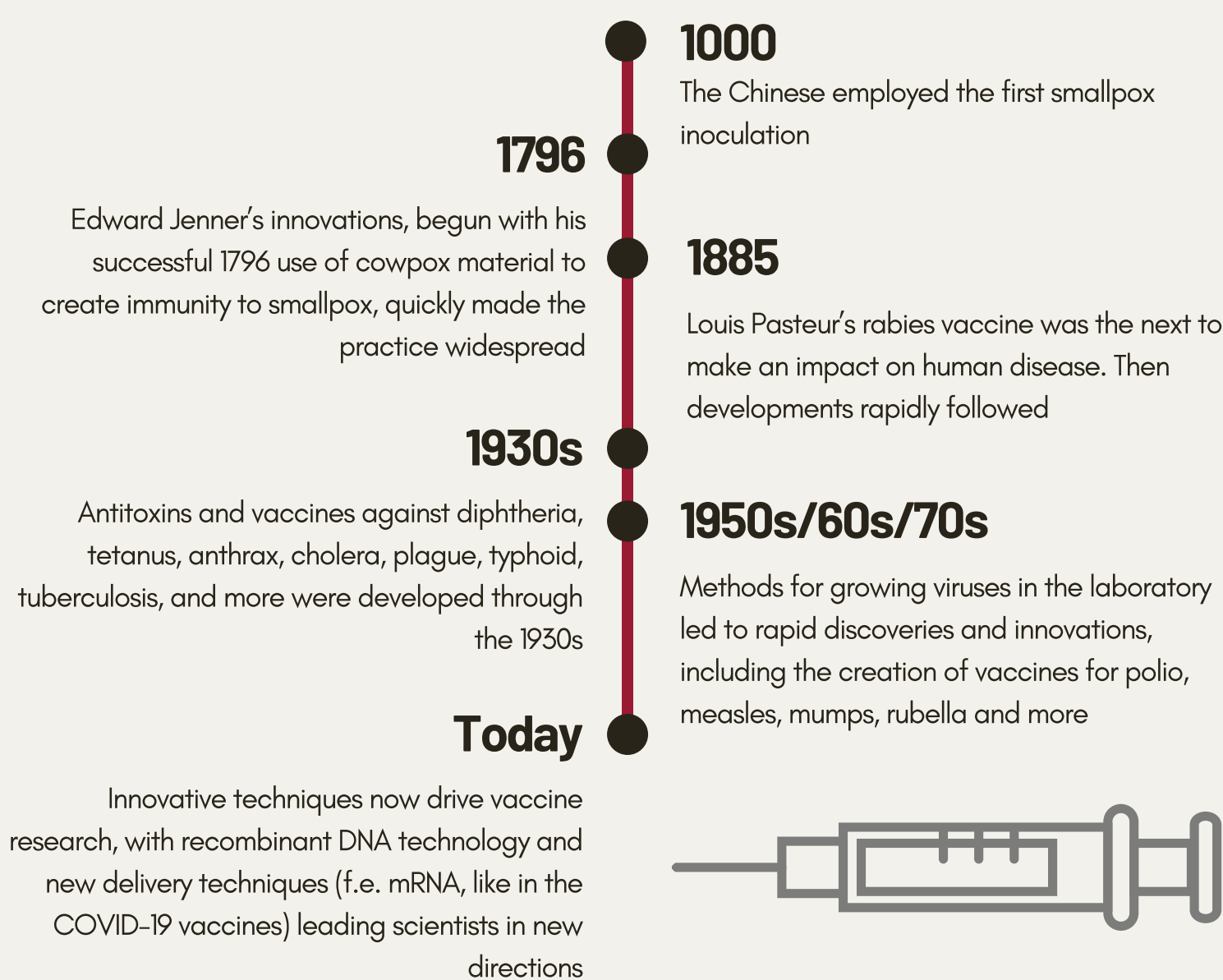
Aims to promote the use of vaccines to protect people of all ages against disease.
